## PRAISE & WORSHIP

*The following is a list of 30 NAMES AND ATTRIBUTES OF GOD. Use this guide for 30 DAYS to enrich your time set apart with God by taking one description of Him and meditating on that for one day, along with the accompanying passage. Worship God, focusing on Him and His character.*

### DAILY ATTRIBUTE OF GOD

**DAY 1 - God is Jehovah.** The name of the independent, self-complete being—"I AM WHO I AM"—only belongs to Jehovah God. Our proper response to Him is to fall down in fear and awe of the One who possesses all authority. —Exodus 3:13-15

**DAY 2 - God is Jehovah-M'Kaddesh.** This name means "the God who sanctifies." A God separate from all that is evil requires that the people who follow Him be cleansed from all evil. —Leviticus 20:7,8

**DAY 3 - God is infinite.** God is beyond measurement—we cannot define Him by proportions or magnitude. He has no beginning, no end, and no limits. —Romans 11:33

**DAY 4 - God is omnipotent.** God is all-powerful. He spoke all things into being, and all things—every micro-organism, every breath we take—are sustained by Him. There is nothing too difficult for Him to do. —Jeremiah 32:17,18; Jeremiah 32:26,27

**DAY 5 - God is good.** God is the embodiment of perfect goodness. He is kind, caring, and full of favor toward all of creation. —Psalm 119:65-72

**DAY 6 - God is love.** God's love is so great that He gave His only Son to bring us into fellowship with Him. God's love not only encompasses the world, but embraces each of us personally and intimately. —1 John 4:7-10

**DAY 7 - God is Jehovah-jireh.** This name means "the God who provides." Just as He provided yesterday, He will also provide today and tomorrow. He grants deliverance from sin, the oil of joy for the ashes of sorrow, and eternal citizenship in His Kingdom for all those adopted into His household. —Genesis 22:9-14

**DAY 8 - God is Jehovah-shalom.** This name means "the God of peace." We are meant to know the fullness of God's perfect peace, or His "shalom." God's peace surpasses understanding and sustains us even through difficult times. It is the product of fully being what we were created to be. —Judges 6:16-24

**DAY 9 - God is immutable.** All that God is, He has always been. All that He has been and is, He will ever be. He is ever perfect and unchanging. —Psalm 102:25-28

**DAY 10 - God is transcendent.** God is not merely eminent, the highest being. He is transcendent—existing beyond and above the created universe. —Psalm 113:4,5

**DAY 11 - God is just.** God is righteous and holy, fair and equitable in all things. We can trust Him to always do what is right. —Psalm 75:1-7

**DAY 12 - God is holy.** God's holiness is not simply our best image of perfection. God is utterly and supremely untainted. His holiness stands apart—unique and incomprehensible. —Revelation 4:8-11

**DAY 13 - God is Jehovah-rophe.** This name means "Jehovah heals." God alone provides the remedy for mankind's brokenness through His son, Jesus Christ. The Gospel is the physical, moral, and spiritual remedy for all people. —Exodus 15:22-26

**DAY 14 - God is self-sufficient.** All things are God's to give, and all that is given is given by Him. Everything we give Him was initially given to us by Him. —Acts 17:24-28

## DAILY ATTRIBUTE OF GOD

DAY 15 - God is **omniscient**. This means God is all-knowing. God's knowledge encompasses every possible piece of information regarding anything that currently exists, existed in the past, or will exist in the future. —Psalm 139:1-6

DAY 16 - God is **omnipresent**. God is everywhere—in and around everything, close to everyone. “Do not I fill heaven and earth?” declares the Lord.” —Psalm 139:7-12

DAY 17 - God is **merciful**. God's merciful compassion is never ending and does not run dry. Through His provision in Christ, He took the judgment that was rightfully ours and placed it on His own shoulders. He waits and works now for all people to turn to Him and to live under His justification. —Deuteronomy 4:29-31

DAY 18 - God is **sovereign**. God presides over every event, great or small, and He is in control of our lives. He rules all creation with all knowledge and power. —1 Chronicles 29:11-13

DAY 19 - God is **Jehovah-nissi**. This name means “God our banner.” Under His banner we go from triumph to triumph and say, “Thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ” (1 Corinthians 15:57). —Exodus 17:8-15

DAY 20 - God is **wise**. God knows and acts with perfect wisdom in all things. He always acts for our good, which is to conform us to Christ. —Proverbs 3:19,20

DAY 21 - God is **faithful**. Out of His faithfulness God honors His covenants and fulfills His promises. Our hope for the future rests upon God's faithfulness. —Psalm 89:1-8

DAY 22 - God is **wrathful**. Unlike human anger, God's wrath is never capricious, self-indulgent, or irritable. It is the right and necessary reaction to objective moral evil. — Nahum 1:2-8

DAY 23 - God is **full of grace**. Grace is God's good pleasure that moves Him to grant value where it is undeserved and to forgive debt that cannot be repaid. —Ephesians 1:5-8

DAY 24 - God is our **Comforter**. Jesus called the Holy Spirit the “Comforter,” and the apostle Paul writes that the Lord is “the God of all comfort.” —2 Corinthians 1:3,4

DAY 25 - God is **El-Shaddai**. This name means “God Almighty,” the God who is all-sufficient and all-bountiful, the source of all blessings. —Genesis 49:22-26

DAY 26 - God is **Father**. Jesus taught us to pray, “Our Father” (Matthew 6:9), and the Spirit of God taught us to cry, “Abba, Father,” an intimate Aramaic term similar to “Daddy.” The Creator of the universe cares for each one of us as if we were the only child He had. —Romans 8:15-17

DAY 27 - God is the **Church's head**. God the Son, Jesus, is the head of the Church. As the head, the part of the body that sees, hears, thinks, and decides, He gives the orders that the rest of the body lives by. —Ephesians 1:22,23

DAY 28 - God is our **intercessor**. Knowing our temptations, God the Son intercedes for us. He opens the doors for us to boldly ask God the Father for mercy. Thus, God is both the initiation and conclusion of true prayer. —Hebrews 4:14-16

DAY 29 - God is **Adonai**. This name means “Master” or “Lord.” God, our Adonai, calls all God's people to acknowledge themselves as His servants, claiming His right to reign as Lord of our lives. —2 Samuel 7:18-20

DAY 30 - God is **Elohim**. This name means “Strength” or “Power.” He is transcendent, mighty and strong. Elohim is the great name of God, displaying His supreme power, sovereignty, and faithfulness in His covenant relationship with us. —Genesis 17:7,8

### Jimmy & Priscilla Abrams

**Location: Tanzania**

**Monthly Support: \$50**

Children: Katelyn, Braden, & Barrett

The Abrams serve as North Texas missionaries to Tanzania. Jimmy and Priscilla bring over 40 years of combined ministry experience in children's, youth, college, and pastoral ministry. Both Jimmy and Priscilla are graduates of Southwestern Assemblies of God University in Waxahachie, Texas. In Tanzania, the Abrams work with the Urban Tribes (global/urban church planting in gateway cities) where they serve as Lead Pastors of The Ocean Church in Dar Es Salaam. Through The Ocean, they partner with the national church (Tanzania Assemblies of God) to reach the unreached in Tanzania.

### Meredith Bagby

**Location: South Africa**

**Monthly Support: \$100**

Meredith is a missionary with Urban Tribes that strategically plants churches in rapidly growing cities across the continent of Africa. She pastors youth and young adults at a church plant in Durban, South Africa. Northplace Church is a place where people of all backgrounds can learn to work together and experience Jesus in a real way. When these culture shapers are disciplined and align their hearts with the heart of God, it will transform the city and even the nation.

### David & Debbie Barthalow

**Location: Rwanda**

**Monthly Support: \$100**

David and Debbie Barthalow have recently been reassigned to Rwanda after serving in Tanzania for 2 1/2 years and Kenya for 12 years. David will be working with the national church of Rwanda in their building program, as well as with Africa Tabernacle Evangelism in building structures across Africa. Construction on new churches is continuing- eighty churches have been closed as a result of not meeting building codes. These churches need water catchment systems, lightning rods and a few other things to be brought up to code. It takes approximately \$11,000 to get these churches back in their buildings. Debbie will continue to work as the Africa Pipeline Coordinator, and bring women's ministry to churches in Rwanda.

### Rick & Elaine Caswell

**Location: Mali**

**Monthly Support: \$50**

Rick, Elaine and Lydia Caswell have ministered in Senegal, Africa for the past 6 years. They have previously lived in Mali and the Ivory Coast. Rick and Elaine lead the Live/Dead team to the Wolof people in Dakar and serve as team leaders for the Senegal field as well. The Wolof people number over 6 million, but there are just approximately 100 from that people group who have put their faith in Jesus. The Caswells moved into Guediawaye, an area in Dakar with approximately a million people, to target the Wolof people in that part of the city. It took a while to get established, but God has given them favor and great friendships in the community.

### Brett & Elise Deal

**Location: Senegal**

**Monthly Support: \$50**

Children: Daphne, Ava, Henry, & Fiona

The Deals are missionaries serving in Senegal, West Africa. They served for 3 years in Northeastern Africa until they were the last AGWM missionaries expelled from that particular country. Since 2014, the Deals have worked in Senegal planting churches, with a passion for missions and multiplying these churches. Brett and Elise have seen men, women, and children from unreached people groups hear the gospel for the first time, come to Christ, and find fellowship with other believers.

### Carrol & Gayle Deal

**Location: Equatorial Guinea**

**Monthly Support: \$100**

Carrol and Gayle Deal serve the countries of the Central Africa area. This area includes Equatorial Guinea, where they have been missionaries since 1987. The primary goals of their ministry have been reaching those who have not had an adequate presentation of the gospel and discipling new believers. After church planting, the Deals prioritize developing Bible schools. They have assisted with Bible schools in Lubumbashi, Democratic Republic of the Congo, and Libreville, Gabon. In November 2018 the Equatorial Guinea Assemblies of God celebrated their 30th anniversary and dedicated the completed campus.

### Shawn & Megan Deal

**Location: Uganda & Rwanda**

**Monthly Support: \$50**

In 1987 Shawn's family became the first Assemblies of God missionaries to the small island nation of Equatorial Guinea in Central Africa. In the following 26 years, his parents led countless people to the Lord, planted over 100 churches, and started the country's first Bible school. In 2017, Shawn and his wife, Megan, were called to pick up the mantle and continue the work his family had started in Africa 30 years before. With 867 unreached people groups in sub-Saharan Africa, representing over 250 million people that have yet to hear of the name of Jesus, there is still a great work to be done! The Deals will be working with the Bible Schools and the youth and young adults in the nations of Uganda, Rwanda, and Burundi. Their hope and prayer is to see a church planted within walking distance of every person.

### Brant & Joanne Jordan

**Location: Sierra Leone**

**Monthly Support: \$50**

The Jordans have worked in Sierra Leone for over four years, and their ministry prioritizes teaching, training, and reaching! They come alongside the Sierra Leone Assemblies of God to equip ministry leaders- Brant with pastoral ministry leaders and Joanne with children's ministry leaders. Their mission is to work with saved people to reach lost people and see the church planted. The harvest is great and through teaching and training, God is saving souls and planting churches!



**Stephen & Bailey Kuert****Location: Kenya, Burundi, Congo**      **Monthly Support: \$50**

The Kuert's are currently involved in church planting in Kenya, Burundi, and Congo. Their ministry works with the KAG in the Masai land of Kenya, with the BAGF across Burundi and the CAGF in the Eastern site of Congo. Their goal is to make the local church the focal point of the entire community. They accomplish this by putting elementary schools on the church property, building playgrounds, and putting in water wells. Their ministry also targets the backside of church planting training through pastoral care, pastoral training, and church planting strategies.

**Bill & Barbara Kuert****Location: Kenya**      **Monthly Support: \$50**

The Kuerts are retired missionaries that are still serving alongside the local churches in Kenya.

**Tim & Jenny Land****Location: Cameroon**      **Monthly Support: \$50**

Children: Whitney & Katelyn

The Land's serve the country of the Cameroon with a focus on ministering to the children of the country. One of the greatest needs throughout the region is the need to minister to the children. With over 40% of the 22 million people being age 14 or younger, there is a great harvest that awaits. Their focus will be to reach children for Jesus and train local church teams to multiply the efforts.

**Jim & Cynthia Lemons****Location: Togo**      **Monthly Support: \$100**

Child: Michael

Jim and Cynthia Lemons have been serving as AGWM missionaries since 1990. They have spent approximately 26 years in Cameroon, Central Africa where they pioneered the Full Gospel Theological School in Mbalmayo. They are now based in Togo, West Africa at the West Africa Advanced School of Theology where they are involved in all areas of ministry training: Bachelors, Masters, and Doctorate. The enrollment from all programs is well over 600 students. They oversee coordinating the extension centers for WAAST which is located in eight African nations currently: Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Cote d'Ivoire, Democratic Republic of Congo, Gabon, Ghana, Madagascar, and Senegal. They also work with the Togo AG in church planting/ construction among unreached and least reached people groups in Togo. Jim also heads up the Francophone committee to establish the first ever French Doctorate program with a Pentecostal emphasis at PThS (Pan Africa Theological Seminary) in Lome.

**Bill & Reita Moore****Location: South Africa**      **Monthly Support: \$100**

Bill and Reita Moore are missionaries who have lived in the countries of Malawi and South Africa and now work across the whole continent. The Moores currently serve in three different roles. Since 2003, they have led the ministry of Africa Tabernacle Evangelism. ATE partners with local churches to build houses of worship and joins with national churches to build Bible schools and other needed facilities. Secondly, they oversee Africa Harvest Ministries. AHM is a consortium of ministries that serve the continent of Africa as a whole. Thirdly, Bill serves as a Strategic Leader for Africa, giving strategic direction for AG ministry on the continent of Africa. Since ATE started, the Moores have participated in constructing almost 3300 churches and other buildings across Africa- enough seating for more than 1 million Africans.

**John & Pam Morton****Location: Sudan**      **Monthly Support: \$50**

Recently the Mortons launched a Live Dead team to Sudan. After arriving in Sudan, they set up residence in a village where there had not been a Christian witness in a 150-mile radius. The Mortons also worked for the local Department of Education.

**Ron & Donna Mueller****Location: Angola**      **Monthly Support: \$50**

The Muellers served for a year in Namibia, Africa and it was there that God began drawing them towards the people of Angola. Ron is an ordained minister with the Assemblies of God and Donna is a registered nurse. They responded to God's call to serve in Angola in 2002. Their current ministry is responding to the need for extension Bible training using Roots of Faith in Portuguese throughout Angola (twice the size of Texas.) There is such a hunger to study God's Word that as soon as the 1 year Bible training course is completed there is a waiting list of students ready to start the next 1 year program. Currently, there are over 3,000 pastors and leaders receiving Roots of Faith training in all of Angola's 18 provinces. They have put up more than 11 tabernacles and are continually receiving requests from pastors of their need for tabernacles. The Muellers are also working on a new location that will serve as a center for ministry and will facilitate travel and work in partnering Angolan pastors and their local churches to reach the people of Angola.

**Kristie Ridge****Location: Botswana**      **Monthly Support: \$50**

When Kristie was in high school, her pastor preached about having a divine appointment with God that would change your life. She went on a mission's trip to London, England with the youth group and while praying, God showed her a picture of the world. The continent of Africa shined out as the place where God was calling her. Kristie is currently a Missionary Associate in South Africa. Her ministry focuses on training children's workers at Jackson's Ridge Children's Ministry Training Centre.



**Jared & Kaila Shoultz**

Children: Ellice, Shiloh, & Hannah

Jared and Kaila Shoultz, along with their three daughters Ellice, Shiloh, and Hannah serve as missionaries to Mozambique, Africa. Their calling and mission is to share the good news of Jesus with the unreached people groups through training and equipping both lead pastors and children's workers. The Shoultzes are currently on itineration and they are witnessing the demon-possessed delivered, souls saved, and churches edified while preparing to leave for the field.

**Location: Mozambique****Monthly Support: \$100****Brian & Crystal Stuke**

Children: Adrianna, Mycayla, & Keith

The Stuke family originally served in Cape Town, South Africa as Missionary Associates. While there, they worked as the Operations Directors at the Global School of Theology Western Cape. The Stukes also worked with teams to build churches and upgrade existing church structures and electrical issues. Now they are heading to Zimbabwe! There the Stukes will be working with the local Bible school, assist with discipleship in local churches, while also leading teams to build tabernacles and water wells in remote villages. Crystal will continue to help vulnerable women and children.

**Location: Zimbabwe****Monthly Support: \$100****Loretta Wideman**

Loretta Wideman is a veteran missionary based out of Nairobi, Kenya. She utilizes Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL) to target unreached people groups with the Gospel. This has been a wonderful way for Loretta to build relationships with people who need Jesus. Since January of 2017, she has held several TESOL seminars and events in Africa and the Middle East to train teachers. Loretta also teaches in the local Bible schools to help train the national men and women to minister in their home areas and around the world.
